A recent study by InfoTrends[™] suggests that many small to medium-sized businesses (SMBs) may be under utilizing their print devices or placing these devices ineffectively throughout their organization^{*}. Market Trends

It is commonly understood in many businesses that print volumes are decreasing.

While there are a number of explanations, they revolve around two key areas – technology and generational shifts. The reality is that today's workers are more comfortable creating and sharing documents electronically than ever before. Simply they no longer feel the need to print as often.

Another significant shift has been the introduction and now near ubiquity of smartphones and tablets. Many workers are viewing and sharing documents electronically, further reducing the need for high-volume printers and copiers.

Businesses Today

The shift in print volumes to smaller, more efficient and less costly devices has left many businesses with "big iron" devices designed for specialty paper sizes or with finishing options that are often underutilized.

Compounding this inefficiency, these centralized devices are often located far from the workgroups who use them, impacting not only their productivity but their satisfaction as well.

These organizations may also have device fleets with a poor employeeto-device ratio or too many devices with different supply types that present a challenge to manage and support.



Businesses may also be in long-term managed services agreements that may have significant hidden costs or are written to support print volumes that these organizations are paying for but no longer producing.

Other Factors

Many businesses may have overlooked recent changes in their own organizations. In the crush of a regular business day, it is easy to miss how changes in workforce composition or outmoded workflows may be contributing to an inefficient output infrastructure.
